



## **120 General Information**

- Age 4-12 for stock classes
- Age 6-12 for Champ and Open

### **Race Format:**

Just like the larger sleds, all 120 classes have 3 rounds and then a final. The first two rounds take place on Saturday. The 3<sup>rd</sup> round and final take place on Sunday. Should an LCQ be required, it will take place on Sunday prior to the final. Attending a drivers meeting is required at the beginning of each day along with a Tech / Safety Inspection. 120's also have practice time at the beginning of each day.

### **120 Practice:**
